Trevor Jacobs reported on road works on Bruce Highway. It took 7 hours to drive from Townsville to Mackay.


-Russ reported that the Administrator has completed her work for the Road Transport Hall of Fame and Rex Mooney is managing the assembly of a new committee.

Thought - this is going to be a wet BBQ - should we continue? Of course we are not afraid of getting wet and we do live in the Territory so onward bound.


At Simpson Gap BBQ area and no other visitors so we had the place to ourselves.


